This Order is made by the Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees "the Authority" under section 26 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that, having regard to the matters set out in section 26(1), there is a need for a public bridleway over the land to which this order relates, and that it is expedient that the way should be created.

The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees have been consulted as required by section 26(3) of the 1980 Act and the Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees have consented to the making of this order.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. There shall be after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order a public bridleway over the land off Roundhill Avenue, Ingleby Barwick described in the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold blue dashed line on the map attached to this Order.

SCHEDULE

Description of Land

The bridleway over land off Roundhill Avenue, Ingleby Barwick, which is approximately 170m in length and 3m in width will create a bridleway link between the New Country Park and Marchlyn Crescent as indicated by a bold blue dashed line on plan no. H117-285.
