

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER  
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, SECTION 257 AND PARAGRAPH 1 OF SCHEDULE 14**

**STOCKTON ON TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL  
PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO.4 – INGLEBY BARWICK (IN PART)  
STOPPING UP ORDER 2021**

The above order was made on 26<sup>th</sup> August 2021. The effect of the Order will be to stop up the public footpath running from point 'G' at GR NZ 4345 1375 to point 'H' at GR NZ 4353 1354 to point 'I' at GR NZ 4358 1348 on drawing H117-285 over land off Roundhill Avenue, Ingleby Barwick as shown on the Order Map.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 1LD between the hours 10am – 1pm and between 2pm – 4.30pm Monday to Friday and on the Council's website (traffic orders). Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at the price of £2.00.

Any representation about or objection to the Order may be sent or delivered in writing addressed to the Highway Network and Flood Risk Manager, Community Services and Transport Directorate, Kingsway House, Billingham, TS23 2YL not later than 27<sup>th</sup> September 2021. Please state the grounds on which it is made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees may itself confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
