THE STOCKTON-ON-TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL (ELEANOR PLACE & BRAMLEY PARADE) PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER 2022

The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees ("The Council") makes this order under Sections 59 and 64 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the 2014 Act")

- 1. This Order shall come into effect on 17th March 2022, and shall have effect for 3 years from that date unless extended by the Council from time to time.
- 2. This Order applies to the area of highway to the rear/side of 25 33 Eleanor Place (odds only) and 18 & 19 Bramley Parade, Stockton-on-Tees as shown edged in red on the plan attached to this Order, hereinafter referred to as "the Restricted Area"
- 3. The Council is satisfied that activities, namely, drug use, drug dealing, prostitution, sex acts in public, and vandalism to public and private property, taking place in the Restricted-Area have had a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality. The Council is also satisfied the activities are, and are likely to continue to be, of a persistent or continuing nature, the activities are unreasonable in nature and justify the restrictions imposed by this Order.
- 4. The public right of way over the Restricted Area is prohibited at all times commencing on the date this Order comes into effect. No person shall pass or repass over the Restricted Area at any time.
- 5. The restriction in article 4 above shall not apply to an occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the Restricted Area, the emergency services, statutory undertakers, utility service providers, persons acting in their capacity as Officers of the Council or persons and/or vehicles required in connection with essential maintenance work
- 6. This Order authorises the council to install gates or other barriers at the entrances to the Restricted Area in the locations marked by a blue line on the plan attached to this Order. The barriers to be erected to give effect to this Order shall be maintained by the Council. - 7. It is an offence to fail to comply with this Order without reasonable excuse, punishable on summary conviction to a fine of up to £1000.
