PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO.7 – STOCKTON (IN PART)  
TEMPORARY FOOTPATH CLOSURE ORDER 2022

Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council propose to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 not less than seven days from the date hereof the Highway Authority being satisfied that access to the said footpath should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be carried out on or near the footpath.

The effect of the Order, which will come into effect on 20<sup>th</sup> May 2022, will be to temporarily close the lengths of public footpath between points A-B (approximately 60 metres) as shown on plan H117-290 from approximately 20<sup>th</sup> May 2022 and will have the effect of public access not being available. During the closure period, an alternative route between Hartburn and Durham Lane (Eaglescliffe) is available via the Six Fields site and Moorhouse Estate using the existing adopted highway and Public Rights of Way network. The plan is available to view on the Council's website (traffic orders). The Order may continue in force for a maximum period of six months unless extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.
