

**STOCKTON-ON-TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL
WHITTON VILLAGE – NORTHERN GATEWAY
TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME**

In accordance with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999, Sections 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council hereby give notice of its proposal to introduce a traffic calming scheme, namely the construction of speed cushions on the Unnamed “C” class link road between Whitton and Stillington. The length of road affected by the proposed traffic calming scheme will be subject to a 30mph speed limit by virtue of street lighting. The location of the speed cushions is specified in the Schedule below. The cushions will measure 2m in length, 1.65m in width and 75mm in height with $\pm 10\%$ tolerance.

Plans showing the proposed scheme may be examined at the Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees during normal office hours and on the Council's website (Traffic Orders). If you wish to object to the proposals, you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to Transport Strategy and Road Safety Manager, Stockton on Tees Borough Council, Community Services, Environment and Culture, Municipal Buildings, Church Road, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 1LD or HTD@stockton.gov.uk by 19 June 2023.

Schedule – Location of Speed Cushions

Unnamed “C” Class Link Road between Whitton and Stillington - Approximately 108 metres north of the junction with Honey Pot Close.
