

**STOCKTON-ON-TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL
IMPERIAL AVENUE & IMPERIAL CRESCENT, NORTON
TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME**

In accordance with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999, Sections 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council hereby give notice of its proposal to introduce a traffic calming scheme, namely the construction of three round top road humps, two on Imperial Avenue and one on Imperial Crescent. The location of the road humps is specified in the Schedule below. The humps shall have an approach gradient of 1:15 that will not exceed 75 mm in height, +/- 10% tolerance.

Schedule – Location of Speed Humps

Imperial Avenue, Norton – Approximately 73 metres [east of its junction with] Norton Road, Norton.

Imperial Avenue, Norton – Approximately 168 metres [east of its junction with] Norton Road, Norton.

Imperial Crescent, Norton – Approximately 262 metres [east of its junction with] Norton Road, Norton.
