- 1. To prohibit waiting at anytime on the length of road specified in the schedule below
- 2. To prohibit road users from U turning from the westbound carriageway of Darlington Road, Hartburn at its junction with Yarm Back Lane onto the eastbound carriageway of Darlington Road and;
- 3. To prohibit road users from turning left from the westbound lane of Darlington Road, Hartburn at its junction with Yarm Back Lane marked as a right turn movement only onto Yarm Back Lane.

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the affected roads and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined on the Council's website (Traffic Orders) or may be examined at the Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees during normal office hours.
