STOCKTON INTERNATIONAL RIVERSIDE FESTIVAL
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023**

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

WHEREAS the Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") is satisfied that traffic should be restricted along the roads specified in the Schedules hereto because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of August 2023 and may be cited as The Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council, Stockton International Riverside Festival, Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023.
2. No vehicle, other than any vehicle used in connection with, or ancillary to, the Stockton International Riverside Festival, shall proceed along the lengths of the road specified in Schedule 1 hereto at any time when traffic management signs have been erected to notify highway users of the closure, expected to be during the approximate times as specified in the third column of that Schedule.
3. No vehicle (except buses and hackney carriages where noted in Schedules 2 and 3) shall stop, wait, load or unload goods at any time when traffic signs have been erected notifying road users of the restriction, except with the consent of a police officer in uniform or a Civic Enforcement Officer employed by Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council, along the roads specified in Schedules 2, 3 and 4 hereto, which roads shall be a clearway for the duration of the restriction.
4. The provisions designating the lengths of road specified in Schedule 5 hereto as parking places shall be suspended at any time when traffic signs or notices have been erected notifying users of the suspension of the parking places and no vehicle shall wait in the parking places at those times, expected to be during the approximate times as specified in the third column of that Schedule
5. The parking places reserved for blue badge holders specified in Schedule 6 hereto shall be suspended from approximately 17:00hrs on Tuesday 1st August 2023 – 18:00hrs on Monday 7th August 2023.
6. No vehicle, including Hackney Carriages, shall wait or stand on the Hackney Carriage Stand specified in Schedule 7 during the hours specified in the third column of that Schedule and the provisions relating to that stand in The Borough of Stockton on Tees Stockton High Street Traffic Regulation Order 2017 (Schedule 9) shall be suspended whilst this article is in force.
7. Nothing in Articles 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 shall apply to Emergency Services, Support Vehicles or Authorised Escort Vehicles.
8. (1) Any unauthorised vehicle parked or left in contravention of this order may be removed by the Council.

(2) Any person removing, or causing the removal of, a vehicle by virtue of this clause may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think reasonably necessary to enable the vehicle to be removed.

(3) Any person removing a vehicle by virtue of this clause shall make such arrangements as he/she considers reasonably necessary for the safety of the vehicle in the place to which it is removed.
