

STOCKTON-ON-TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL PRINCE REGENT STREET, STOCKTON TEMPORARY PARKING SPACES CLOSURE ORDER 2023

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

WHEREAS the Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") is satisfied that access along the said section of road specified in Schedule I hereto shall be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be carried out on or near the road.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

- I. The Order shall come into operation on the 4th September 2023 and may be cited as the Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council, Prince Regent Street, Stockton Temporary parking spaces Closure Order 2023.
- 2. No vehicle including hackney carriages shall proceed along, wait, load or unload goods or passengers the length of the road specified in Schedule I hereto at any time when traffic management signs have been erected to notify highway users of the closure
- 3. The Order may continue in force for a maximum period of 18 months.

SCHEDULE I

Temporary Parking Spaces and Hackney Stand Suspension

Location	Extent
Prince Regent Street,	From a point approximately 40 metres north of its junction with Yarm
Stockton (East side)	Lane for a distance of approximately 58 metres in a northerly direction.
