THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES YARM BACK LANE/DARLINGTON ROAD, STOCKTON TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council made the above Order on the 21st September 2023 under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The Order, which will come into effect on the 22nd September 2023, will have the effect of:

- 1. Prohibiting waiting at anytime on the length of road specified in the schedule below
- 2. Prohibiting road users from U turning from the westbound carriageway of Darlington Road, Hartburn at its junction with Yarm Back Lane onto the eastbound carriageway of Darlington Road and;
- 3. Prohibiting road users from turning left from the westbound lane of Darlington Road, Hartburn at its junction with Yarm Back Lane marked as a right turn movement only onto Yarm Back Lane.

The Order together with a map showing the affected roads may be examined on the Council's website (Traffic Orders) or may be examined at the Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees during normal office hours. If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under them has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 21 September 2023 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Schedule 1 - No Waiting at any time

Yarm Back Lane, Stockton (east side) from its junction with Darlington Road, Hartburn in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 135 metres.
