

STOCKTON-ON-TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL
CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING PROGRAMME 2023/2024
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE ORDER 2023

Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council propose to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 not less than seven days from the date hereof the Highway Authority being satisfied that access to the said road should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be carried out on or near the roads.

The effect of the Order, which will come into effect on 2nd October 2023, will be to temporarily close various lengths of road within the Borough, a list of which can be viewed on our website at:

Such closures will be at such times as traffic management signs may be erected to notify highway users of the closure. It is expected that works will be carried out from approximately 2nd October 2023 over an 18-month period. The Order may continue in force for a maximum period of eighteen months.

The contractor will carry out a letter drop at each location and give the affected residents prior notification of when works are to commence on site. Works will be carried out using rolling road closures affecting limited lengths of carriageway where appropriate. The bus operators are to be updated when works affecting bus routes/stops are to commence on site. Diversion routes will be signed on site. Access for pedestrians and emergency services will be maintained at all times during the works. Access will be maintained for residents wherever possible.
