## STOCKTON-ON-TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL STOCKTON HIGH STREET, REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY SERVICE 2023 TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023

Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the 9<sup>th</sup> November 2023, the Highway Authority being satisfied that access to the said highway should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.

The effect of the Order, which will come into effect on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2023, will be to temporarily close parts of High Street, Knowles Street and Church Road, Stockton and introduce a clearway (during which no vehicle shall stop, load or unload goods or passengers or wait) along parts of High Street East Side Service Road, High Street, Knowles Street and Church Road, Stockton at any time when traffic signs have been erected notifying road users of the restrictions. The Order may continue in force for a maximum period of eighteen months. Access for pedestrians and emergency services will be maintained.

Further details of the lengths of road affected by the closures and clearways are contained in the Order and map which can be viewed on the Council's website (search for traffic orders).
