

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES
ENVIRONMENTAL 7.5 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION
ORDER 2020**

The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 15th day of October 2020 and may be cited as The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees, Environmental 7.5 Tonne Weight Restriction Order 2020.
2. In this Order “civil enforcement officer” shall mean a person employed by the Council as a Civil Enforcement Officer or other officer authorised by the Council to enforce traffic restrictions.
3. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle exceeding 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight to enter or proceed along the lengths of the road specified in the Schedule hereto.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to
 - i) public transport vehicles namely buses as defined in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981 or any community transport vehicle being a vehicle originally adapted to carry more than eight passengers which has been modified to carry wheelchairs.
 - ii) emergency vehicles
 - iii) vehicles exceeding the weight limit that require access to premises along a road specified in the Schedule where there is no other access other than along that road
 - iv) a vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, being used in connection with building, industrial or demolition operations (subject to obtaining the prior written consent of the Council); the removal of any obstruction to traffic; the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said roads; or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on the roads or land adjacent to the roads of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984 (or any successor legislation);
 - v) any vehicle if it cannot be conveniently used for such purposes in any other road, being used in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties

Wolviston Road	Between its junctions with Thames Road and Wynyard Road.
High Street, Wolviston	Between its junctions with Wynyard Road and Durham Road.
Coal Lane, Wolviston	Between its junctions with A689 and Durham Road.
The Green, Wolviston	Between its junctions with Coal Lane and Wynyard Road.
Durham Road, Wolviston	Between its junctions with High Street and Coal Lane.
Wolviston Back Lane	Between its junctions with Hurworth Road and Cowpen Lane.
Hurworth Road	Full length.
Auckland Road	Full length.
Bowhill Way	Full length.
Cowpen Bewley Road	Between its northern kerbline junction with Macklin Avenue and its junction with Cowpen Lane / Marsh Lane.

Finchale Avenue, Billingham	Between its junctions with Rievaulx Avenue and Tintern Avenue.

Ragpath Lane	Between its junctions with B1274 Junction Road and Darlington Lane.

Beaconsfield Road, Norton	Between its junctions with A139 Billingham Road and The Green.
Darlington Back Lane / Darlington Lane	Between its junctions with Yarm Back Lane and A177 Durham Road.

Darlington Road	Between its junctions with Durham Lane and C140 Mill Lane roundabout. To include the length of road from the eastern A66 Long Newton junction in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 128 metres.
A67 Uray Nook Road	Between its roundabout junctions with C139 Uray Nook Road and Durham Lane.

Thornaby Road	Between its junctions with Millbank Lane and Trenchard Avenue.
Myton Way	Between its junctions with Ingleby Way and Lowfields Avenue.
Broom Hill Avenue	From its junction with Myton Way in a north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 98 metres.
The Rings	Full length.
B1265 (Allerton Balk, Worsall Road)	Full length between B1264 Green Lane and A67 The Spital.
Leven Road, Kirk Road, Valley Drive, Mount Leven Road, Lingfield Road, Glaisdale Road (all Yarm)	Full lengths.
Forest Lane, Kirklevington and Back Lane, North Yorkshire	Full length between A67 Thirsk Road and C152.
C147 (Middle Bank, Thorpe Road), Thorpe Thewles / Carlton	Between its junctions with Durham Road, Thorpe Thewles and C144 Letch Lane / Carlton Village.
Durham Lane, Eaglescliffe	Between A67 Urray Nook Road (Tesco) and Chaldron Way (Kingsmead) roundabouts.

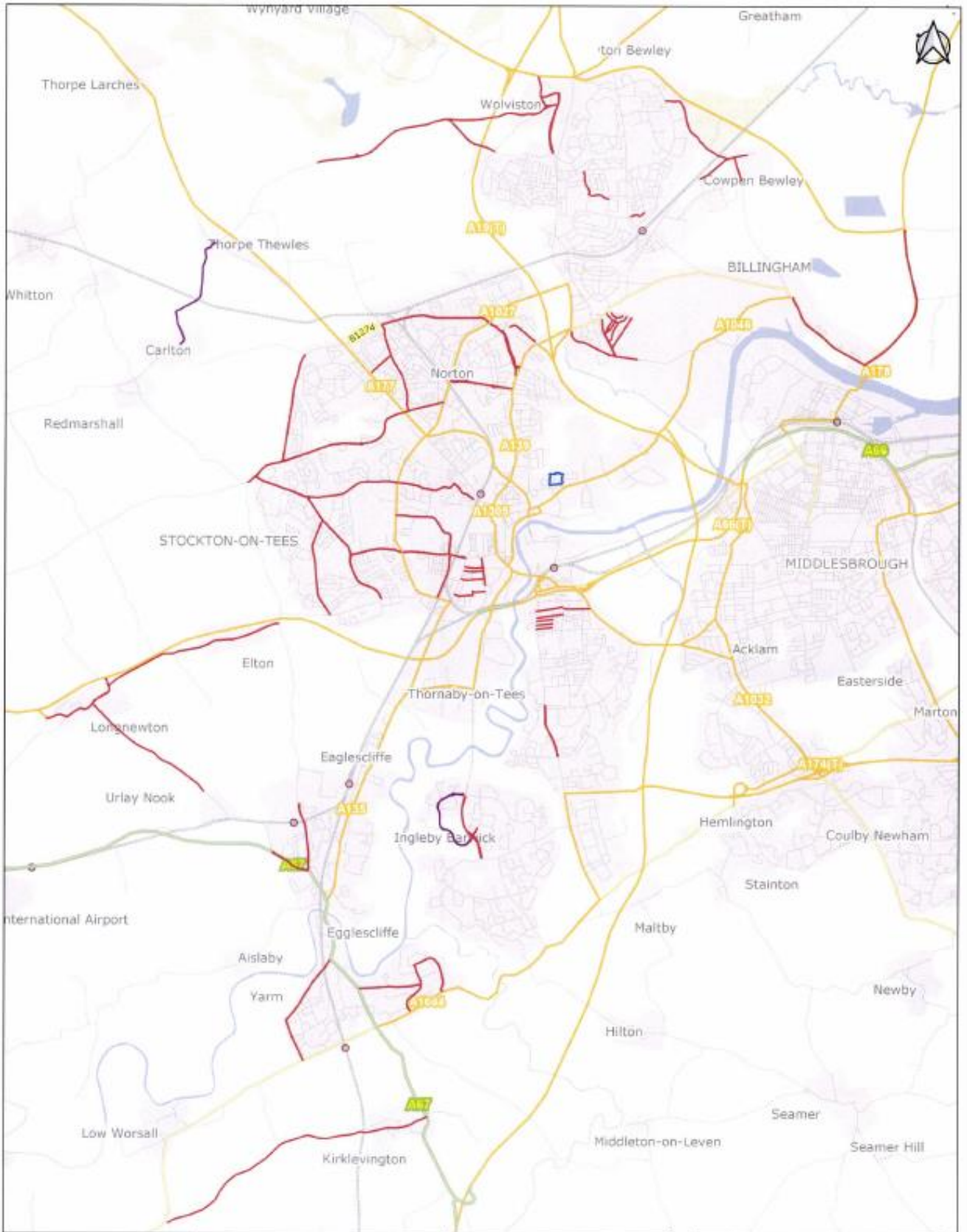
