

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES
(STOCKTON TOWN CENTRE ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2017
(AMENDMENT) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023**

Notice is hereby given that Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council made the above Order on 30th November 2023 under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The Order, which came into effect on 30th November 2023, has the effect of prohibiting any vehicle waiting at any time or loading or unloading between the hours of 7am to 9.30am and 4pm to 6pm Monday to Saturday along the length of road as specified in Schedule 1, and implementing short stay parking places for on-street charges to the length of road specified in Schedule 2.

The Order, together with a map showing the affected roads, may be examined at the Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees during normal office hours and on the Council's website (Traffic Orders). If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under them has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 30th November 2023, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE 1 -

Norton Road, Stockton (East Side) – From its junction with Queen Street in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 14 metres.

SCHEDULE 2 –

Norton Road, Stockton (East Side) – From a point approximately 14 metres south of its junction with Queen Street in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 60 metres.
