

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES  
(STOCKTON TOWN CENTRE ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2017  
(AMENDMENT) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023**

The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023 and may be cited as The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (Stockton Town Centre On-Street Parking Places) Order 2017 (Amendment) Traffic Regulation Order 2023.
2. The definitions of the 2017 Order shall apply to this Order unless stated otherwise.
3. No vehicle shall wait at any time along the length of road specified in Schedule 1.
4. No vehicle shall load or unload goods along the length of road specified in Schedule 2 during the hours of 7am-9.30am and 4pm-6pm Monday to Saturday.
5. Schedule 3 of The Borough of Stockton on Tees (Stockton Town Centre On-Street Parking Places) Order 2017 (the 2017 Order) is hereby varied by the deletion of the wording in the second column of Schedule 3 of this Order and the insertion of the wording in the third column of Schedule 3 of this Order but shall otherwise remain on full force and effect.

The Borough of Stockton on Tees (Norton Road, Stockton-on-Tees) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 1999 shall be varied in so far as it is necessary to give effect to this Order.

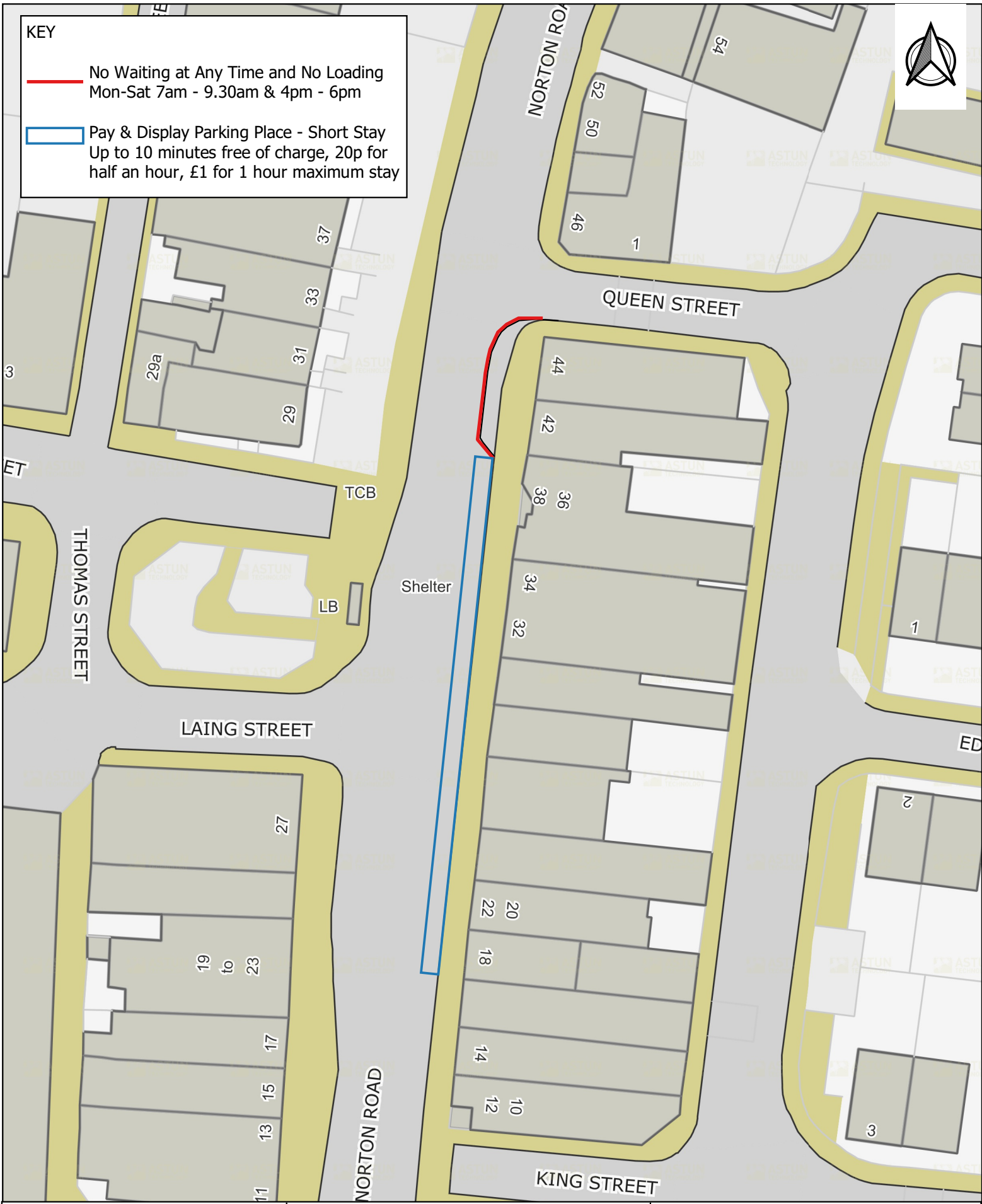
