## THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES (STOCKTON TOWN CENTRE ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2017 (AMENDMENT) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023

The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023 and may be cited as The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (Stockton Town Centre On-Street Parking Places) Order 2017 (Amendment) Traffic Regulation Order 2023.
- 2. The definitions of the 2017 Order shall apply to this Order unless stated otherwise.
- 3. No vehicle shall wait at any time along the length of road specified in Schedule 1.
- 4. No vehicle shall load or unload goods along the length of road specified in Schedule 2 during the hours of 7am-9.30am and 4pm-6pm Monday to Saturday.
- 5. Schedule 3 of The Borough of Stockton on Tees (Stockton Town Centre On-Street Parking Places) Order 2017 (the 2017 Order) is hereby varied by the deletion of the wording in the second column of Schedule 3 of this Order and the insertion of the wording in the third column of Schedule 3 of this Order but shall otherwise remain on full force and effect.

The Borough of Stockton on Tees (Norton Road, Stockton-on-Tees) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 1999 shall be varied in so far as it is necessary to give effect to this Order.
