

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES  
BUTTS LANE AND GRISEDALE CRESCENT, EGGLESCLIFFE TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2018  
AMENDMENT ORDER 2023**

The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023, and may be cited as The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees Butts Lane and Grisedale Crescent, Egglecliffe Traffic Regulation Order 2018 Amendment Order 2023.
2. The Borough of Stockton on Tees (Butts Lane and Grisedale Crescent, Egglecliffe) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (2018 Order) is hereby varied by the insertion of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule of this Order into the Schedule of the 2018 Order. The 2018 Order shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.

**SCHEDULE 1 – Roads to be added to the Schedule of the 2018 Order**

Grisedale Crescent, Egglecliffe (North side)	From a point approximately 10 metres east of its junction with Butts Lane, in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres.
Grisedale Crescent, Egglecliffe (South side)	From a point approximately 10 metres east of its junction with Butts Lane, in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres.  From its junction with the west side of Borrowdale Grove in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres.  From its junction with the east side of Borrowdale Grove in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres.
Borrowdale Grove, Egglecliffe (West side)	From its junction with the south side of Grisedale Crescent in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres.
Borrowdale Grove, Egglecliffe (East side)	From its junction with the south side of Grisedale Crescent in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres.
