

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES
(CHURCH ROAD AREA, STOCKTON-ON-TEES) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1997
AMENDMENT (NO.4) ORDER 2024**

Notice is hereby given that Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The Order will have the effect of amending existing regulations to reduce the reserved parking spaces for Disabled Badge Holders along the lengths of road as specified in Schedule 1 hereto and implementing new no waiting and no loading at any time restrictions to the length of road as specified in Schedule 2.

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the affected roads and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees during normal office hours and on the Council's website (Traffic Orders). If you wish to object to the proposed Order, you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to Network and Traffic Team Leader, Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council, Municipal Buildings, Church Road, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 1LD or HTD@Stockton.gov.uk by 8th February 2024.

SCHEDULE 1 – Reserved Parking Spaces for Disabled Badge Holders

Thistle Green/The Square (Western Leg) (west side) - From a point approximately 36 metres north of its junction with Bishop Street in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 19 metres
From a point approximately 96 metres north of its junction with Bishop Street in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 14 metres

SCHEDULE 2 - No Waiting and No Loading at Any Time

Thistle Green/The Square (western Leg) (west side) - From a point approximately 55 metres north of its junction with Bishop Street in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 41 metres
