

**STOCKTON ON TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL  
(PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO.9 (PRESTON) IN PARTS)  
PUBLIC FOOTPATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023**

On the 25<sup>th</sup> January 2024, the Council of the Borough of Stockton on Tees confirmed the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert Footpath No. 9 – Preston, shown running from point A (GR NZ4261,1532) to point B (GR NZ4272,1527) on the Order map (drawing reference H117-298), and create an alternative route running from point A (GR NZ4261,1532) in a south easterly direction for a distance of 25m to point C (GR NZ4263,1532) continuing in a south easterly direction for a distance of 100m to point D (GR NZ4272,1528), then in a southerly direction for a distance of 6m to point B (GR NZ4272,1527) shown on drawing H117-298.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge on the Council's website (Traffic Orders) and at Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees during normal office hours. Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at the price of £1.

The Order came into force on the 25<sup>th</sup> January 2024, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 31st January 2024, make an application to the High Court.
