### THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES HARTBURN LANE & HARTBURN AVENUE, STOCKTON TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024

The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 2024 and may be cited as The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees, Hartburn Lane & Hartburn Avenue, Stockton Traffic Regulation Order 2024.
- 2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer or a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait along the lengths of the roads specified in Schedule 1 of this Order at any time.
- 3. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer or a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle proceeding along the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to make a left turn, any vehicle proceeding along the length of road specified in Schedule 3 to make a right turn, or any vehicle proceeding along the length of road specified in Schedule 4 to make a U-Turn.
- 4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle, including bicycles, to proceed along the length of road specified in Schedule 5 of this Order other than in the direction specified therein, at any time.
- 5. Nothing in Regulation 2 of this Order shall prohibit any vehicle waiting on the sides of the roads referred to therein for as long as may be necessary to enable:
  - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations, subject to obtaining the prior written consent of the Council;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement, or reconstruction of the said sides of roads, or
    - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration, or repair of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity, or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunication Act 1984, to those sides of roads or in land adjacent to the said sides of the roads.
  - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting "postal packets" as defined in Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000.
- 6. Nothing in Regulation 2 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used for fire brigade purposes, or which is an ambulance or a vehicle in the service of a local authority, statutory undertakers or police force, in any case being used in pursuance of statutory duties or powers.
