

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES
THE GREEN, NORTON
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024**

Notice is hereby given that Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council made the above Order on 29th April 2024 under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The Order, which came into effect on 29th April 2024, has the effect of introducing new no waiting or loading at any time restrictions to the length of road specified in Schedule 1 below. The sealed Order, together with a map showing the affected roads, may be examined at the Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees during normal office hours and on the Council's website (Traffic Orders).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under them has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 29th April 2024 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE 1 – No Waiting and No Loading at Any Time Restrictions

The Green, Norton (West side) – From its junction with Bradbury Road in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 3 metres.
