

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES  
NORTON HIGH STREET, NORTON  
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2016  
(AMENDMENT No 2) ORDER 2024**

Notice is hereby given that Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council made an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The Order which came into effect on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2024, has the effect of amending existing regulations to increase the existing no waiting and no loading at any time restrictions to the length of road as specified in Schedule 1. The sealed Order, together with a map showing the affected roads, may be examined at the Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees during normal office hours and on the Council's website (Traffic Orders).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under them has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 30<sup>th</sup> April 2024 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
