## THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES NORTON TOWN CENTRE, NORTON (NO. 2) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 & 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The Order will have the effect of introducing new designated bays for loading only between the hours of 5am to 6pm along the length of road specified in Schedule 1 hereto, introducing new no waiting at any time restrictions, except for Hackney Carriages between the hours of 6pm to 5am, along the length of road specified in Schedule 2, and introducing new limited waiting restrictions along the length of road specified in Schedule 3, from Monday to Saturday between the hours of 9am to 5pm for 2 hours, no return within 2 hours.

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the affected roads and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees during normal office hours and on the Council's website (Traffic Orders). ## Schedule 1 – Proposed Designated Bay for Loading Only – 5am to 6pm

**High Street West Side Service Road, Norton (West Side)** – From a point approximately 78 metres south of its junction with Leven Road in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 12 metres.

## Schedule 2 – Proposed No Waiting at Any Time, except Hackney Carriages 6pm – 5am

**High Street, Norton (East Side) –** From a point approximately 86 metres north of its junction with Norton Road for a distance of approximately 24 metres.

## Schedule 3 – Proposed Limited Waiting - Monday to Saturday, 9am to 5pm - 2 hours - No Return Within 2 Hours

**High Street West Side Service Road, Norton (West Side) –** From a point approximately 66 metres south of its junction with Leven Road in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 12 metres.
