#### THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES NORTON HIGH STREET, NORTON TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2016 AMENDMENT (NO.3) ORDER 2025

The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 & Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 2025 and may be cited as The Borough of Stocktonon-Tees Norton High Street, Norton Traffic Regulation Order 2016, Amendment (No.3) Order 2024.
- 2. This Order hereby varies The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees Norton High Street, Norton Traffic Regulation Order 2016 ("the 2016 Order") and The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees, Norton High Street, Norton Traffic Regulation Order 2016 Amendment Order 2016 ("the 2016 Amendment Order") shall be amended as follows but shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.
- 3. Schedule 4 of the 2016 Order shall varied by the deletion of the wording set out in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 4. Schedule 4 of the 2016 Amendment Order is hereby varied by the deletion of the wording in the second column of Schedule 2 of this Order and the insertion of the wording in the third column of Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 5. The lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 of this Order shall be added to the 2016 Order as Schedule 10.
- 6. The following wording shall be inserted into the 2016 Order as a new article 12.
  - 12. No person shall, except upon the direction, or with the permission, of a Civil Enforcement Officer or a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait along the carriageway specified in Schedule 10 at any time.
