

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES
NORTON HIGH STREET, NORTON TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2016
AMENDMENT (NO.3) ORDER 2025**

The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 & Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on 2025 and may be cited as The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees Norton High Street, Norton Traffic Regulation Order 2016, Amendment (No.3) Order 2024.
2. This Order hereby varies The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees Norton High Street, Norton Traffic Regulation Order 2016 ("the 2016 Order") and The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees, Norton High Street, Norton Traffic Regulation Order 2016 Amendment Order 2016 ("the 2016 Amendment Order") shall be amended as follows but shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.
3. Schedule 4 of the 2016 Order shall varied by the deletion of the wording set out in Schedule 1 of this Order.
4. Schedule 4 of the 2016 Amendment Order is hereby varied by the deletion of the wording in the second column of Schedule 2 of this Order and the insertion of the wording in the third column of Schedule 2 of this Order.
5. The lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 of this Order shall be added to the 2016 Order as Schedule 10.
6. The following wording shall be inserted into the 2016 Order as a new article 12.
 12. No person shall, except upon the direction, or with the permission, of a Civil Enforcement Officer or a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait along the carriageway specified in Schedule 10 at any time.

SCHEDULE 1

Location	Wording to be deleted
Leven Road, Norton (south side)	From its junction with High Street West Service Road in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 60 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

Location	Wording to be deleted	Wording to be inserted
Leven Road, Norton (North Side)	From a point approximately 22 metres west of its junction with High Street West Service Road in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 82 metres.	Leven Road, Norton (north side) From a point approximately 12 metres west of its junction with High Street West Service Road in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 46 metres.

SCHEDULE 3 – No waiting at anytime, carriageway only

Location	Wording to be inserted
Leven Road, Norton (north side)	From a point approximately 58 metres west of its junction with High Street West Service Road in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 50 metres.
Leven Road, Norton (south side)	From its junction with High Street West Service Road in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 101 metres.
